She loves to put on a show for her mom and dad. To Dance, sing or play. She likes to pretend she is a princess. She loves to dress up... and be beautiful.




...And she has such dreams for the future.

Her tears flow.




She looks for love in other places, but she is always heart broken.

She finds that He wants to know the desires of her heart.






He places her on a path of righteousness.

He has an adventure for you . He has a place for you in his kingdom and he gives you his armor to fight and be victorious.






One of the most important jobs we can have is to lead other women to the Cross too.
